Objectives 2012-2013

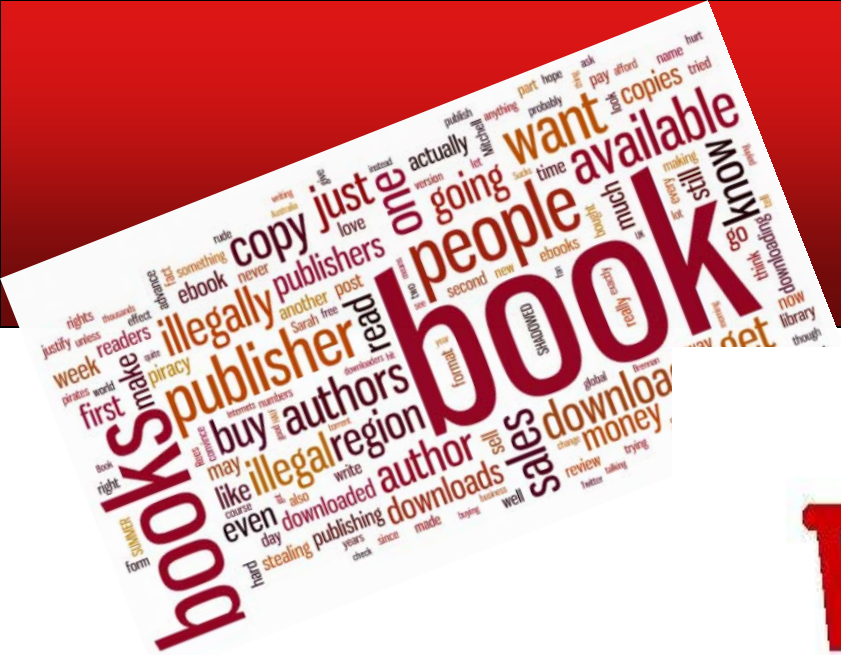


1. Develop a CAET Resource Catalogue
