## CAET ACADEMY AWARD

### The Gail Hawke “Trail Blazer” Award sponsored by Nightingale Medical for a CAET Academy ETNEP Graduate in the Province of British Columbia

#### Description of Award:

This \$2,500 financial award will be given annually to one B.C. Graduate of the CAET Academy ETNEP Program who has demonstrated that she/he is a “Leader” in the tri-specialty of ET Nursing and who meets the criteria written for this award. It is administered by the Canadian Association for Enterostomal Therapy in cooperation with an awards advisory committee. Nightingale Medical Limited will pay \$2,500 to CAET and CAET will disperse this same amount to the award recipient.

#### Objectives:

- Provide financial support to a B.C. based CAET ETNEP Graduate who has demonstrated leadership and innovation in wound, ostomy and continence care as an integral part of the healthcare team
- Acknowledge the career contributions made by Gail Hawke as a “Trail Blazer” making a positive impact on Enterostomal Therapy Nursing and the specialized care of wound, ostomy and continence patients
- Motivate a B.C. CAET ETNEP graduate to think outside of the box in creating new opportunities to build the profile of E.T. Nurses and ET Nursing practice in order to support wound, ostomy and continence patients

#### Criteria:

##### The recipient of this award must:

- Be a resident of British Columbia
- Be a Member of the CAET in good standing
- Have graduated from the CAET Academy ETNEP Program

- Have demonstrated commitment to E.T. Nursing through on going volunteer work in relation to the care of wound, ostomy or continence patients above and beyond day to day work/job as a specialized nurse within the healthcare system or by being actively involved in a CAET Committee or Core program which will impact Enterostomal Therapy Nurses regionally and or Nationally
- Submit an essay describing how they have been a “Leader” in wound, ostomy and or continence care no more than 800 words in length which would be reviewed and scored by the CAET Awards committee
- Must be selected by the CAET Awards Committee
